Recent Successes

- The University of Maryland Medical Center (UMMC) and the R Adams Cowley Shock Trauma Center, Baltimore, MD, selected MetaVision for their 55 operating rooms. The Shock Trauma Center, the only trauma hospital in the US, is considered to be one of the best worldwide.
- *iMDsoft* has entered the Portuguese market with the Hospital José Joaquim Fernandes in Beja to install MetaVision in their ICU, ORs, pre-op, induction and recovery rooms. *iMDsoft* and SpaceMedical of Portugal cooperated to provide the solution.
- In March, Ziekenhuis Gelderse Vallei, a 605-bed hospital in Ede, the Netherlands, chose MetaVision for its operating rooms, holding and recovery rooms, intensive care unit, medium care unit and a trauma room in the emergency room. The choice of MetaVision replaces a system from another major vendor. *iMDsoft* and ItéMedical cooperated to provide the solution.

Recent Go-Lives

- BJC HealthCare of St. Louis, one of the largest nonprofit healthcare organizations in the US, has gone live with MetaVision in the Orthopedic Center as the hospital begins the roll out of MetaVision in 59 operating rooms, 15 ambulatory beds and for its 102 pre/post operative beds.
- When the 300-bed Henry Ford West Bloomfield Hospital, Detroit, Michigan, opened its doors on March 15, *iMDsoft's* MetaVision went live on its 12 Adult ICU and 7 NICU beds. 12 additional Adult beds will be added this summer.
- Holmes Hospital of the University Hospital (UCMC) in Cincinnati, Ohio, went live with MetaVision in 5 ORs.
- Diaconessenhuis, Utrecht, the Netherlands, has gone live with MetaVision, bringing the *iMDsoft* solution to their 11-bed general ICU ward. *iMDsoft* replaces an existing system.

- *iMDsoft's* new website recently went live, including Dutch, French and German versions. The site includes revised messaging, targeted to specific client audiences, and a new design and structure.
- In March, *iMDsoft* unveiled MetaVision Suite 2009 (Version 5.46), which is now being released gradually.
